Each year, SJC graduates are asked to complete a survey about their transition to a career and provide details about their current (or soon to be) position. Surveys are sent beginning about a month prior to graduation, with reminders sent every two weeks until a month after graduation. Two final reminders are sent in September to those who have not replied.

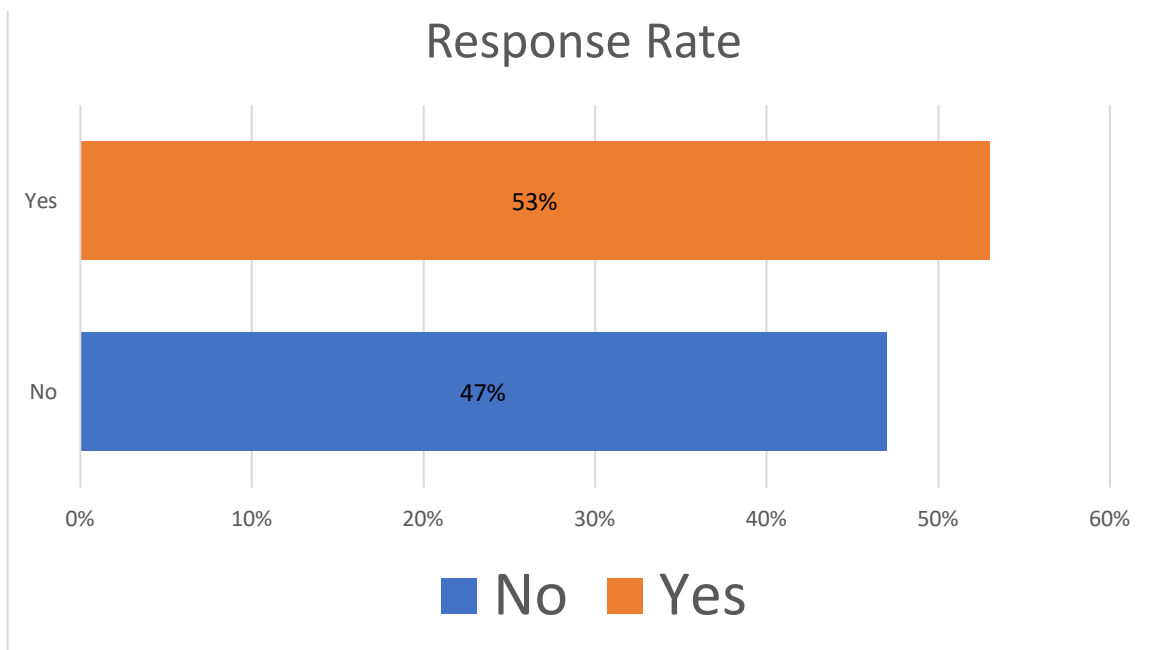

## Saint Joseph’s College Class of 2019

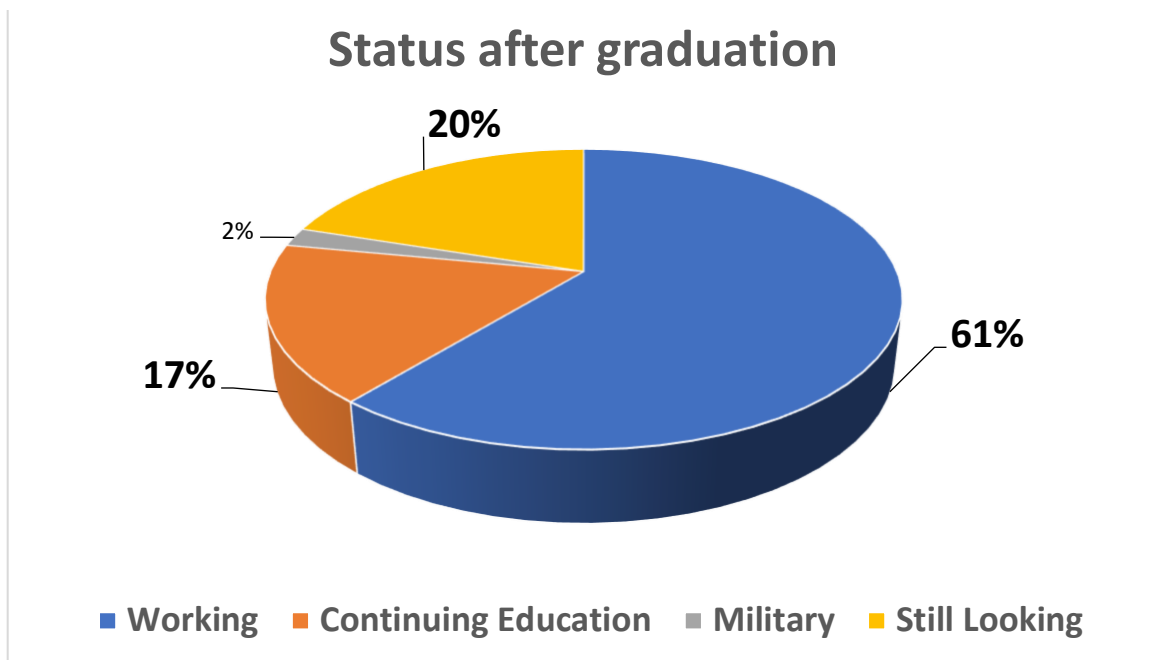
### Survey Response Rate

For the class of 2019, 110 of our 206 graduates responded to the survey.

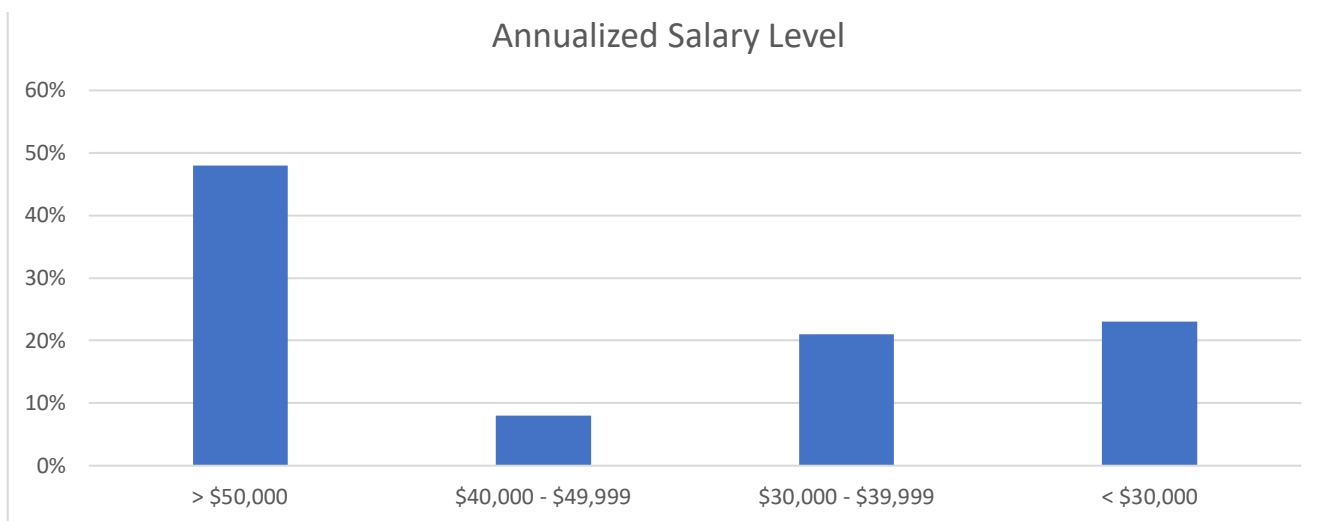
